- Rule Book Changes/ Updates for approval. – Larry Abbott – The intent is to clean up the language in the rule book:
  - General Club Rules A change from “Guest” to “Guest/ Shooting Guest” – **Approved**
  - Rule E. Members Guests: Adding “Return shooting Guest badge and sign out” – **Approved**
  - Basic Range Rules Changing 500 M range to “200-300-500 M Range” – **Approved**
  - Rule C: added language “No magnetic/ steel core ammunition is to be shot at steel targets” – **Approved**
  - Rule H: Change from All Brass to “Spent Cartridges” – **Approved**
  - Rule I: Change from Recommended to “Required” – **Approved**
  - Rule S: Change to “and shooting in one continuous motion” – **Approved**
  - Black Powder Change from No Modern guns allowed on this range to “Inline muzzle loading guns are allowed on this range, but must not be shot at steel plates. 22 rim fire firearms in Only 22 Long, Long Rifle, and Short rifle firearms are allowed on this range.” – **Approved**
  - Rule 8 Rim Fire Benchrest changed from general shooting members to “Non participants” – **Approved**
  - Adding “Cowboy holster draw at cowboy range only. Precertification required” – **Approved**
  - Adding “Rule M Youth Air Rifle:
    - Must be between 8 and 18
    - Must have a current parent consent for on file
    - Must be able to pass a shooting safety test
    - Must be able to follow directions
    - All safety rules are to be strictly enforced” – **Approved**
  - Infraction Schedule to be added as follows:

INFRACTION SCHEDULE

    1. Violations not involving a firearm such as not signing in guests, etc., two points maximum per incident.
    2. Unsafe action involving an Unloaded firearm. Three points per incident.
    3. Unsafe Action involving a loaded firearm, Six points per incident.
    4. Intentional unsafe action with a loaded firearm or intentional damage to Club Property, Loss of membership  
Six points = one Month suspension of club membership from date badge and key is turned in.  
Eight points = two-month suspension of club membership from date badge and key is turned in and reissue of green badge after suspension.  
Twelve points = loss of club membershipPoint system will be from February 1<sup>st</sup> through January 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year. The Chief Range Officer (CRO) or (his/her) designee will maintain a record of all violations and attached incident reports. The CRO will inform the executive board when action is due. – **Approved**
