- Rules Committee: **TABLED UNTIL NEXT MONTH**
  - INDOOR AMMUNITION ALLOWED
    - Straight cased pistol caliber non-magnum in handguns only
    - No rifles or carbines except 22 long rifle, pellet and bb guns
  - \*If in doubt, ask the Chief Range Officer or Pistol Director
- 2020 Elections – Nomination list to be posted. Enter your name on the appropriate position. If you no longer wish to be on the board, line out your name. If you are on the board and want to continue then please initial by your name. Looking to streamline the elections. Contested position will be allowed to speak at the election night to promote themselves for votes. - Phone Call – Had phone call from Beloit Township Police Oct 27<sup>th</sup> regarding rounds leaving back range. Local resident by club claimed they herd round going through their trees. With the location of the property and claimed direction, it was determined the round(s) did not come from our range. Non-issue for us.
- Steel Targets on rifle ranges – Steel targets must be placed within a foot of the bullet traps. This will reduce the likelihood of bullets leaving the back range. Black Powder Cartridge will need to make adjustments for their matches out back. The 150/200-yard range on Black powder is a concern since it doesn't have any ridge or bullet trap. This will be looked at with Wally Marshall and Don Rotzoll. Needs to be addressed that laying down in front of the bench on the back range there is a chance to see blue sky.
- Dennis Munn – Question regarding shooting in the indoor range with having the extra door up. The noise from the indoor range has been reduced because of this door being added. Does the range need to be shut down when something is going on? Need to make sure it is ok with who ever is using the meeting room is the general consensus. Exception is board meetings; this range is closed.
